Situation Update, Uttarakhand: 05/04/2020

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease.

A total of 983 samples have been collected for COVID-19 testing till date. Result of 894 samples received, 868 are negative and 26 are positive. Result of 89 samples is awaited.

Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts.

Public Health Action taken:

- To fight against COVID-19, orders are issued that all medical students who have passed final year exam in March 2020 will commence their internship immediately.
- Government has notified helpline number to provide psychological support to the people suffering from mental stress due to pandemic situation/lockdown.
- State's 2nd COVID-19 testing centre has been made functional in AIIMS Rishikesh.
- Screening of **Tablighi Jamat followers** is continued.
- Ayurveda's immunity boosting measures for self care during COVID-19 crisis disseminated for awareness.
- Regular messages on **Do's & Don'ts** during lock down period are released for public awareness through print, electronic and social media. FM Radio and Community Radio are widely used.
- Uttarakhand government launched a Mobile App "Uttarakhand COVID-19 Tracking System" as a platform for people to report and self declare, if they are suspecting COVID-19 signs and symptoms. The link of App is https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.app_release.covid19finalcourse

APPEAL :

Department of Health and Family Welfare, Uttarakhand appeals to all citizens of the state to follow the advisory for **lockdown**. All persons who have been advised quarantine (Contacts of Positive cases and people who have come from foreign travel) have to observe mandatory home quarantine as instructed by authorities. They may stay in separate room and not venture outside their house. If a person found/reported to be not following home quarantine as guideline, he/she will be put under institutional/facility quarantine. In case of any health emergency, assistance due to lockdown they may call state control room number 0135-2609500/helpline number 104/District control room numbers (Annexed) for assistance.

Preventive measures:

- Home quarantine of all asymptomatic travellers for next 28 days after returning from COVID-19 affected countries.
- Travellers and their families members must ensure strict respiratory and hand hygiene. Cover your face while coughing or sneezing, wash hands frequently and avoid hand shakes.
- Travellers coming to India from COVID-19 affected countries must report to district/block health authorities immediately if they develop any symptoms like fever, cough, cold or difficulty in breathing.
- Indian citizens are advised to refrain from non essential travel to COVID-19 affected countries.
- Hospital isolation of all symptomatic travellers if they have returned from any of COVID-19 affected countries.
- Frequent hand washing specially after touching any body secretions like saliva or nasal secretions.
